Training and mentoring in Bees for Development's approach to poverty alleviation and biodiversity conservation. Based at the BfD offices in Monmouth for 10 days training and mentoring.

Study visits including beekeepers specialising in sustainable beekeeping practices; botanic gardens to learn in more detail about pollination - 10 days.

Meeting with partner organisations including beekeeping, biodiversity, communications and safeguarding organisations - 10 days.
