Professional Fellowship in Facial Plastic Surgery. Previous Fellows hosted have had hands on experience and acted as observers. Unfortunately, the previous fellowship was cut short after a month due to the COVID outbreak.

All the Fellows were trained in various facial plastic surgery procedures and they went back to their country to perform these procedures for the local population and to train junior doctors in the same skills. Regular teaching sessions are organised each year in their institutions, and ongoing support is provided by DBTH in these activities to make sure the training progresses in the expected manner.

Eligibility

A surgeon registered with the host countries medical council who has received training in ENT surgery or Plastic Surgery, with at least 2 years post qualification experience will be eligible. All eligible Fellows must be medically qualified.

Proposed Fellowship Dates

21/02/2024 to 22/05/2024

Proposed Activity

Three clinics and six theatres a week. One session for audit and research. Each Fellow will be encouraged to do an audit as well as at least one peer reviewed paper during their fellowship. Each fellow will be working under supervision of an ENT specialist. Subsidised stay will be arranged in the campus. Fellows will be encouraged to attend the local and regional courses related to facial plastic surgery and present papers in these meetings.
