Remote Learning Agreement: Scholars undertaking virtual study from their Home Country in 2020

In response to the unprecedented situation caused by Covid-19 the CSC have agreed to relax the following requirements in line with its current policy:

- scholars must remain in the UK (except for authorised absences or annual leave) during their scholarship

-scholars are not permitted to be outside of the UK for unauthorised travel and where this is exceeded, stipends will be suspended until the scholar returns to the UK.

The Commission has agreed to continue to make stipend payments to Scholars who study remotely from their home country until the completion of their degree or until their award end date, whichever is sooner.

For the CSC to continue paying your stipend, you are now asked to confirm and agree to the following conditions:

- 1. I have left the UK* (and I am, and will continue to undertake the full-time studies for which my Commonwealth Scholarship was awarded, working remotely until the scheduled course and award end date (as detailed in my Notification of Award)**
- 2. I understand that if I do not continue with my studies remotely, or do not complete my degree, I may be required to return stipend to the CSC**
- 3. If I complete the requirements of my degree before the scheduled end date (as detailed in my Notification of Award) I must inform my Programme Officer of my new completion date as soon as possible, as this may have an effect on my stipend payments**

***You must provide evidence of your return home where your flight was not booked through Diversity Travel**

By signing this Remote Learning Agreement, you are agreeing to the conditions set out within it.

Please return this form and evidence that you have left the UK (where travel was not booked through Diversity Travel) to your Programme Officer; your stipend may be withheld if you do not return this agreement.
