You will be asked to upload the references, on institutional letterhead or an email clearly showing the sender's details, at the end of the application form.

Your application will be considered ineligible unless it is accompanied by at least two references. It is your responsibility to ensure that each of your referees is able to complete the reference by the deadline. Some examples of a referee's relationship to you are Supervisor at work, Personal referee and Master's supervisor.




