The fellowship is designed for mid-career medically qualified clinical microbiologists from Commonwealth LMIC who are in positions to influence service delivery, training, and policy.

The programme offers structured, supervised, work-based learning within accredited clinical microbiology laboratories and multidisciplinary clinical teams. Fellows will observe how diagnostic microbiology, antimicrobial stewardship systems, and IPC are integrated into routine patient care and public health.

This fellowship is explicitly designed to transfer practical, adaptable skills that can strengthen health systems in LMIC settings. LNWH's experienced faculty, comprehensive infrastructure, and commitment to post fellowship engagement ensure that training translates into measurable development outcomes aligned with Commonwealth priorities.

Eligibility

Applications are invited for the Professional Fellowship in Clinical Microbiology, Antimicrobial Stewardship and Infection Prevention & Control from mid-career medically qualified clinical microbiologists from Commonwealth LMIC who are in positions to influence service delivery, training, and policy. Applications are encouraged from Governmental or Charitable organisations, particularly with those LNWH has professional collaborations and the extent to which skills acquired during the fellowship will lead to practical benefits for the organisation and the country. Candidates should have the leadership potential to have a catalytic effect within the region or country and in establishing new relationships with the UK.
