

University of East London- School of Health, Sport and Bioscience - Professional

The School of Health, Sport and Bioscience at UEL will host five fellows through the Commonwealth Professional Fellowship Scheme. The programme is designed to integrate a short course on professional development, teaching observation, external visits to industries and other HEIs, attendance at workshops on assessments and feedback, a research conference at UEL. During this programme, the prospective fellows will get opportunities to network with academic and industrial scientists. They will become familiar with teaching, assessments and feedback methods in the UK. The short course on professional development will enable them to gain hands-on experience with state-of-the-art instruments including their applications, troubleshooting and data analysis. These activities will underpin the professional skills of the prospective fellows from developing countries, and thus positively impact their abilities to implement these skills and adapt teaching and learning methods in their own home countries upon their return.

Eligibility

The prospective fellows through the Commonwealth Professional Fellowship Scheme are expected to be early or mid-career academic staff from the developing countries like Bangladesh, India, Pakistan, Ghana, Nigeria, etc. As the School of Health, Sport and Bioscience at UEL will host these fellows, it is expected that the fellows should have academic backgrounds in Bioscience or related disciplines. Applicants irrespective of their sex, race, religion, culture, ethnicity and sexual orientation are encouraged to apply for the Commonwealth Professional Fellowship in the School of Health, Sport and Bioscience at UEL.
